MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walkthrough period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a turf surface. Ring size will be 70'x115'

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space will be available on a limited basis. The event site requires a tarp or other cover to be placed on the floor underneath your crates and chairs. Crates may be left overnight; however, the American Pomeranian Club Inc and Flying Feet Agility LLC will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Pomeranian Club Inc and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Pomeranian Club Inc reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Pomeranian Club Inc or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. If the trial is cancelled because of COVID-19, the APC will offer a full refund to exhibitors.

Bitches in season and injured dogs are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Please note: Refund of entry fees for injured dogs or bitches entered in the trial that come in season after the closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the trial secretary before the start of the show. Entry fees will be refunded less \$5.00 per run AKC and judge's fee.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. 

The above grid is to show you some of the steps we have taken to make us all safe at our trial.

The yellow area is all aisle, no crating or seating in these areas. Each exhibitor will have a 4 ft deep x 6-foot-wide crating space.

There will be NO crating along the front of the overhead doors. There is a 3 foot wide aisle between each row of crating which will allow 7 foot between your chair and the chair of the person across from you and 6 foot from the chair of the people on either side of you. This is space for 40 exhibitors. Because of the limited space, during this trial there will be no ex-pens or playpens allowed. All dogs must be in either a soft-sided or wire crate. There will be no exceptions.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower

then their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

I understand the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at these agility trials held at Flying Feet Agility October 23-25, 2020 may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, The American Pomeranian Club, Inc. show staff, employees, volunteers, participants, attendees and their families. I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold The American Pomeranian Club, Inc., its agents, officers, directors, employees, volunteers, attendees, or other participants from any claim.

Social Distancing:

- I will, to the best of my ability, practice proper social distancing as recommended by the State of Indiana, "Back on Track" directives, as well as practicing good hygiene (hand washing, use of hand sanitizer, wearing a mask at all times when in the building except when running my dogs (mask may be taken off in the ring and placed in your pocket, then put back on before exiting the ring) and when around other people on the grounds) and follow any other health recommendations.
- I will not sit in groups closer than 6 feet and will practice social distancing in holding areas, while walking the course, in the parking lot, and on the show site. Crating areas will be taped out, and you must stay within your space. All chairs will be in the spot marked for your chair to maintain the 6 ft distancing. No chairs at ringside.
- I agree to have my temperature taken before I enter the premises at Flying Feet. I also agree to have my temperature taken at any time during the show weekend.

Health Reporting:

- I have not experienced any symptoms of possible COVID-19 in the last 14 days, including cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste of smell, diarrhea, feeling feverish or a temperature greater than 100°. I have not had close contact with a person symptomatic or confirmed to have COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- I have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days. If I have been infected by COVID-19 at any time, I have been medically released to return to normal activities. If I develop a fever and symptoms, such as a cough or difficulty in breathing, or if I am diagnosed with COVID-19 withing 14 days of this event, I will report this information to The American Pomeranian Club, Inc.
- Should symptoms develop during the event, I will report symptoms to the trial chair and trial secretary and immediately leave the trial.

Other changes due to COVID-19:

- Only exhibitors will be allowed at the trial during the pandemic. No family members unless the exhibitor is a junior handler, who may have 1 (one) parent in attendance with them.
- This site has many acres where you can walk or play with your dogs and maintain social distancing. Please consider this as an option to staying in the building unless you are working.
- As stated, face masks must be worn when in the building or when near other people outside. Exhibitors are responsible for bringing their own masks. They will not be supplied by the club or Flying Feet Agility.
- Course maps will be posted for you to take a picture of, there will be no paper course maps at this trial. Please social distance while taking pictures of the maps.
- Due to the pandemic there will NOT be food at this trial. We encourage you to pack a lunch. PLEASE No MACH/PACH CAKES OR SHARED FOODS OR SNACKS.

- Walk throughs will be limited to 25 exhibitors, and you must wear your mask and maintain social distancing.
- Handlers may put their leash in their pocket or wear it during their run, there will be a leash runner for those wishing to drop the leash at the start line. The leash runner will use a grabber that is dipped in disinfectant between each leash.
- There are 2 sinks in the building, and we will have a table with sanitizer next to the porta potty. Please wash your hands often throughout the day.
- No self-serve ribbons, a member will be putting the sticker on ribbons and the results will be posted on the overhead door for you to see. There will be marks on the floor to aid in your social distancing.
- Each person will check themselves in with their own pen, BEFORE walking the course.
- If you are not feeling well, PLEASE stay home. Contact Ruth Ann Stewart, our trial secretary, and you will be given a refund (minus AKC & Judges Fees) for each day you are absent. People running a fever, or visibly sick will be asked to leave with no refund.

COVID-19 has changed the way we do things in life, and agility trials are no exception to this. We ask that if you are entering APC's trial that you are comfortable with our guidelines and are willing to comply with all rules. Exhibitors not in compliance with these guidelines will be excused from the trial without a refund.
